

Research Collaboration Programme Year 2

Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand, Egypt, Kenya and Turkey

- initiate new research and innovation collaborations between academic groups, departments, and institutions
- develop existing collaborations at group, departmental, and institutional level
- encourage these collaborations to work with nonacademic organisations and individuals to support the exchange of research and innovation expertise and the translation of research knowledge into tangible benefits



Project duration 22-24 months



Size of Grant **180,000** (200k FEC)

Small scale seed funding for collaborations between the UK and the participating ISPF countries/territories



Take your time to study the guideline before apply

- UK Lead Applicant submit application through our portal at https://grants.britishcouncil.org/
 - Applicants need to register at the website before applying.
 - Once submitted, the application can be edited at any time before the deadline (9 July 10.00 AM UK time)
 - You will be asked to select one Thai funder you would like to apply for.
 - All the required documents must be attached with the correct file name in the portal
 - Carefully read through the correct forms and format of these documents (Resume, Letter of Support and etc.)
- Thai applicant may need to submit proposal parallelly through NRIIS, depending on the Thai funder
 - Carefully check our application guideline, especially the appendices at the end from each Thai partner.
 - In case of dual-application process, both applications must be submitted by the deadline.
 - Applying to the correspond funder to your area of interest or expertise is highly encouraged
