

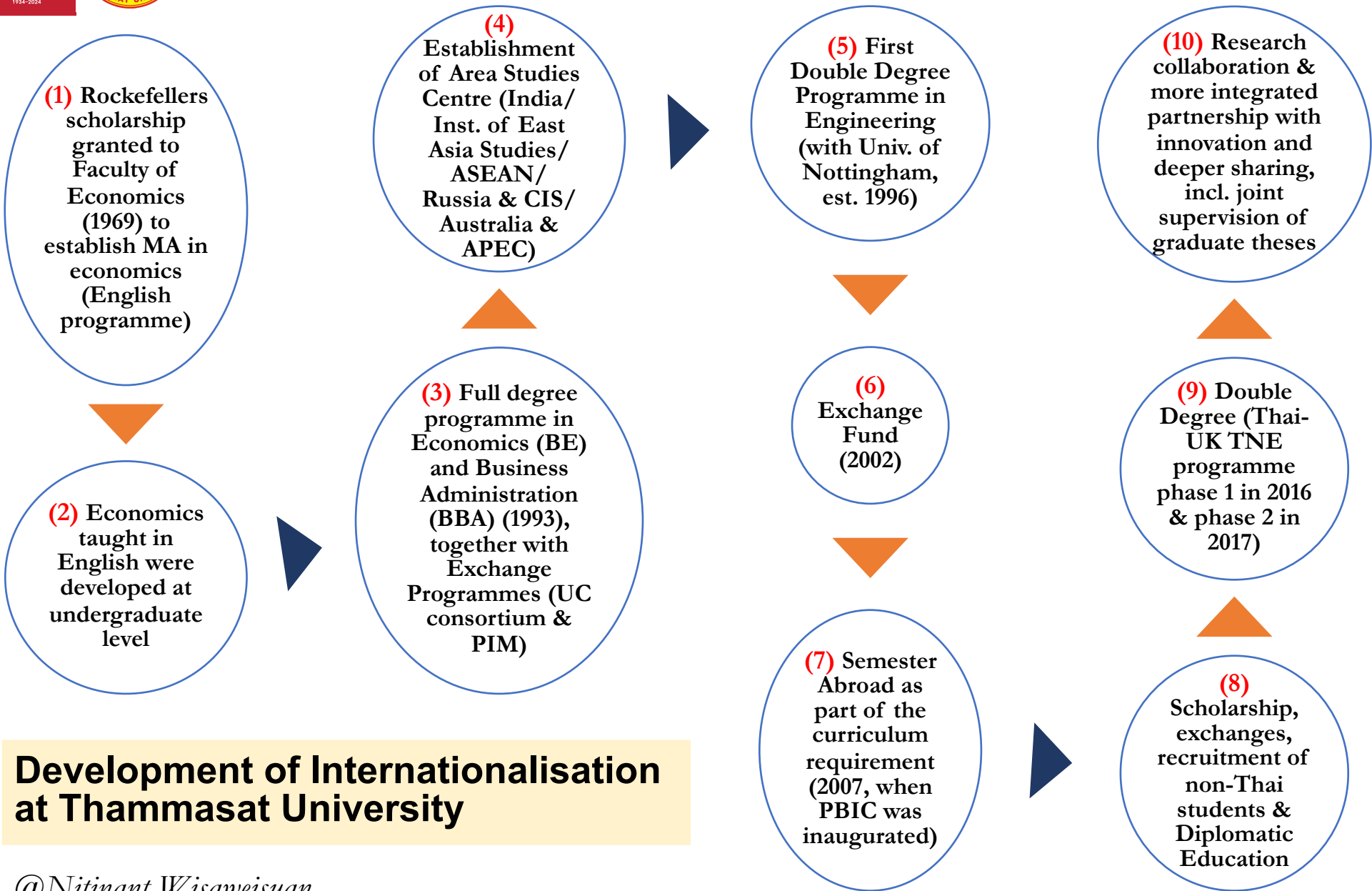

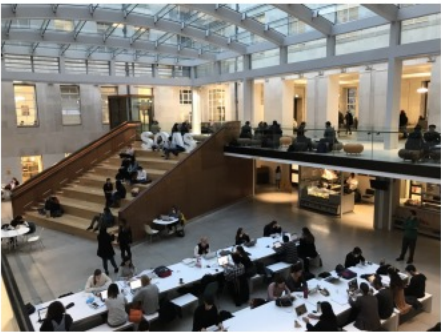


Development of Internationalisation at Thammasat University

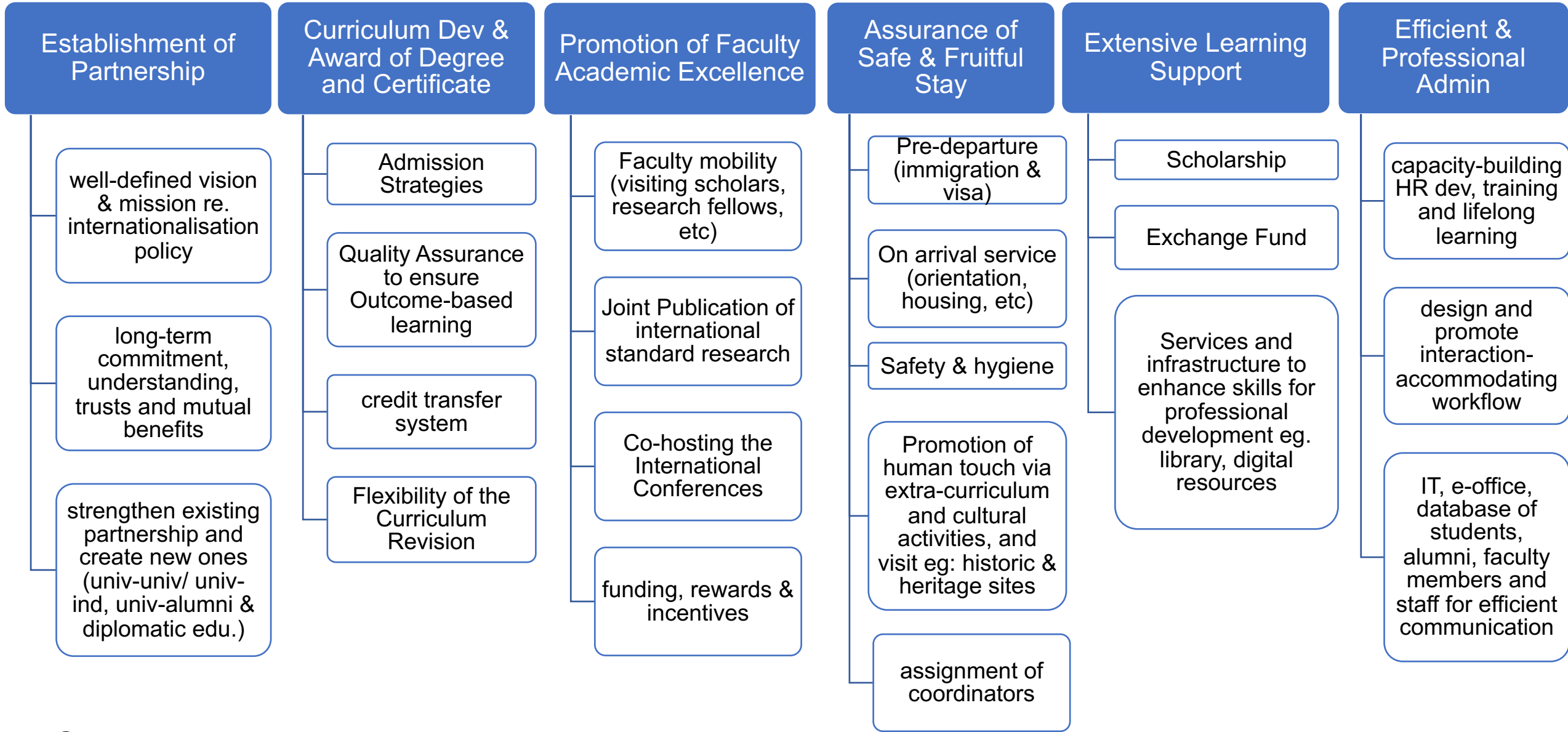
