#### **BUILD COLLABORATIVE NETWORKS :**

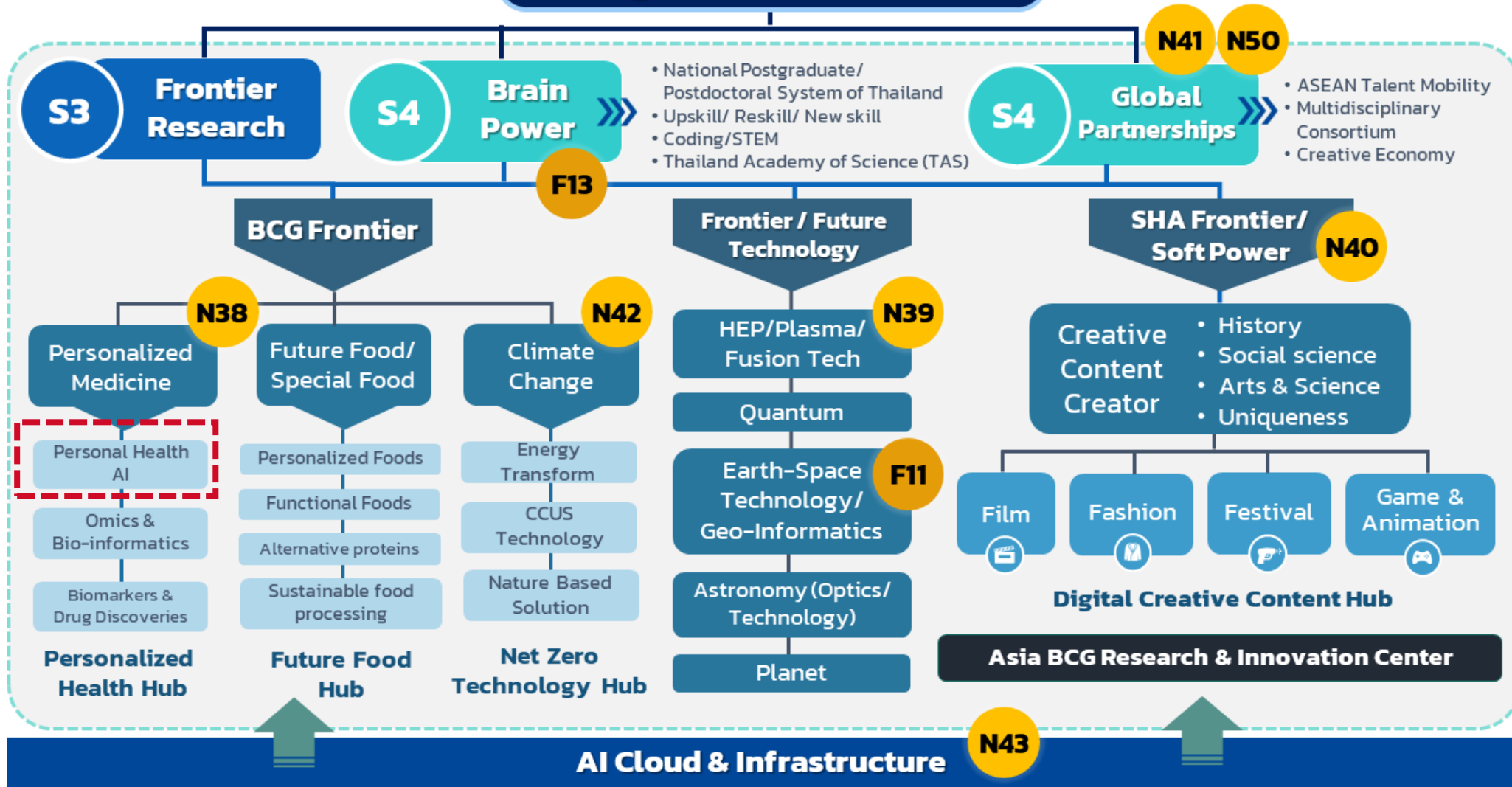

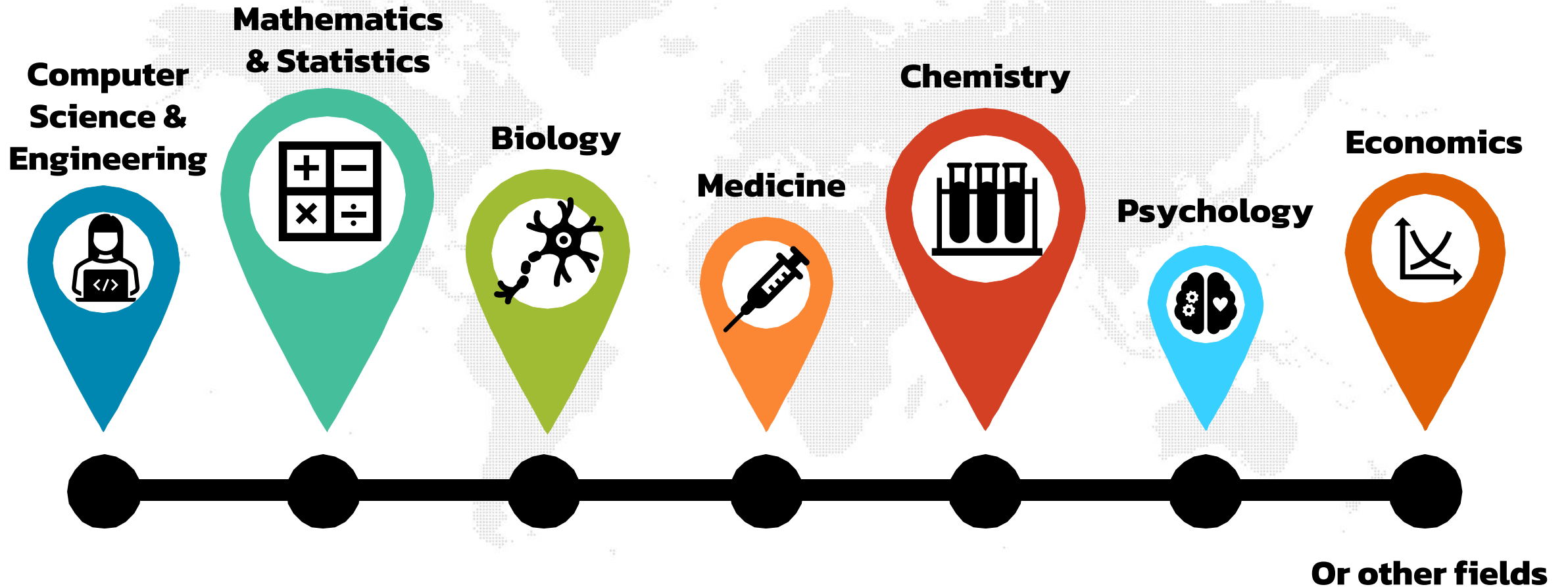

**Total budget :** up to **£80,000**

UK Maximum: £40,000

Thailand Maximum: £40,000

**Duration of grants :** **12-18 month**

**Number of projects to be funded:** **Up to 1 project**

**Priority areas:** Priority 3 Promote Capacity Building and Knowledge Exchange in Interdisciplinary Research (**Personal Health AI**)

## **Eligibility Criteria for Thai applicants**

- The Project Leader must be a **Thai national or a non-Thai individual** affiliated with one of the aforementioned Thai organizations. There should be **at least two institutes or universities** in Thailand involved in the project, conducting diverse field research.

## **Submission process**

- There will be only one application to be submitted to **the British Council**.
